

# Susan's Knitted Cotton Washcloth

**Yarn:** 35 oz Sugar'n Cream  
100% cotton (from Michael's  
or JoAnn Fabrics)

**Needles:** US #6

**Gauge:** doesn't really matter

**Final Size:** 8 inches square

CO 40 stitches on #6 needles.

1st row: k across all stitches

2nd row: k2 \*k1 p1\* 18 times then k2 last stitches

3rd row: same as 2nd row

4th row: same as 1st row

REPEAT ROWS 1 - 4 a total of 14 times. Cast off after the last row 4.

NOTES: The 2nd and 3rd row make a k1 p1 ribbing on both RS and WS. The 4th and 1st row make a garter stitch ridge. The 2 k stitches on each end of every row make a 2 stitch garter edging to keep the whole thing flat.

Keep going until you have 14 interior garter stitch ridges. Just count the ridges between the CO and C off. Do not count the CO and Cast off in counting your ridges. 14 ridges makes a square for my gauge. Adjust the number of repeats as necessary to create a square washcloth.
